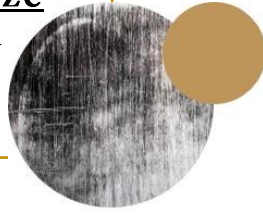




Hadley's School Prize

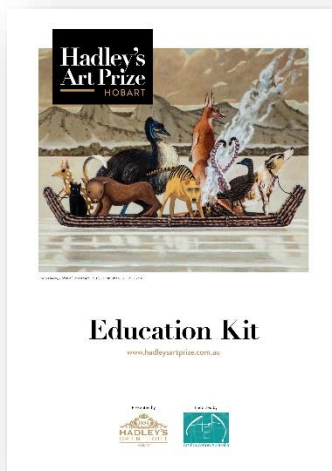
This prize is to be judged by Dr Amy Jackett, Curator of the Hadley's Art Prize, Dr Margaret Baguley, President of Art Education Australia, and Dr Abbey MacDonald, Vice President of Art Education Australia.

To enter, schools need to complete the entry form and submit 1 – 3 images from the relevant 'Making' section of the HAPH Education kit:

- Years 5 – 6: Creating a postcard for 'favourite place' exhibition
- Years 7 – 8: Creating a postcard exhibition exploring the theme of 'Place'
- Years 9 – 10: Developing a classroom body of work for exhibition that explores a theme

The images are to be accompanied by a written description (up to 500 words) of the classroom exhibition which demonstrates careful consideration of the Responding information in the HAPH Education Kit, including how they have been inspired by the HAPH exhibition, or a short video 3 – 5 minutes of the student exhibition with students speaking about the HAPH and their interpretation which may also include a brief 200-word description.

About the Hadley's Art Prize Education Kit



Presented by Hadley's Orient Hotel, the Hadley's Art Prize is an Australian landscape art prize which offers \$100,000 to the winning artwork.

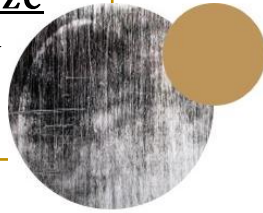

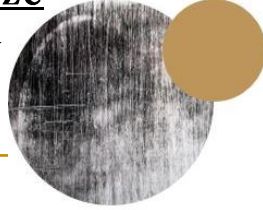
Conditions of Entry

3. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
4. The competition commences 21 July 2018 and closes 25 August 2018.
5. Use of artwork and images:
 - a. By entering this competition and accepting the conditions of entry, entrants grant Hadley's Orient Hotel, Art Education Australia and Artery non-exclusive rights to reproduce the images entered in digital and material form for purposes relating to the Hadley's Art Prize, including marketing, publicity, educational and publication uses in perpetuity.
 - b. The name of the school and names of the artists will be attributed when their entered images and/or video are used.
 - c. Entrants will not receive any fee for such reproductions of entered images or video.
6. The winning school will be notified 1 (one) month following the close of the Hadley's Art Prize finalists' exhibition, on Tuesday 25 September 2018, and presented to the winning school soon after.
