Bus subsidies to visit the 2019 Hadley's Art Prize Hobart finalists' exhibition, learn about the artworks and have morning tea at Hadley's Orient Hotel

The University of Tasmania's (UTAS) College of Arts, Law and Education (CALE) is generously offering bus subsidies to schools to enable students to visit the 2019 Hadley's Art Prize Hobart (HAPH) finalists' exhibition.

UTAS greatly values and promotes the authentic learning experience of firsthand art analysis for students but realises that the costs of bus hire can be prohibitive, especially for those schools an hour or more away from Hobart. UTAS aims to help by offering a financial subsidy to assist in the cost of bus travel for students to attend the exhibition at Hadley's Orient Hotel in Hobart.

There are three subsidies available, worth \$400 each, to provide schools with \$250 towards bus transportation to Hadley's Orient Hotel and \$150 towards morning tea at Hadley's Orient Hotel.

Teachers, please note: this is a subsidy program and if your application is successful you will need to book your own bus/es. Morning tea will be arranged by Hadley's Orient Hotel.

Schools that visit the HAPH exhibition will be met by the curator or another member of the HAPH staff who has working with children registration and be shown through the exhibition. Teachers can use the activities in the HAPH Education Kit to further engage students. The HAPH Education Kit is a comprehensive curriculum- and context-specific education kit, which focuses on the Australian landscape through making and responding, and is endorsed by Art Education Australia, the peak national body for visual art education in Australia. Schools that engage with at least one of the activities in the HAPH Education Kit can enter the Hadley's School Prize which has a prize of \$1000 voucher for art supplies from Artery in Hobart.

This bus subsidy selection will be by representatives from UTAS CALE and Art Education Australia. Preference will be given to schools of lower socio-economic status who have not yet had an art excursion. We recommend teachers obtain a quote from a bus company before applying for this subsidy. Please note that this subsidy may not cover the full cost of the transportation. Schools will be required to meet any additional transportation costs.
